THANK you for the many donations and grants that have been received by VIC in the last month to secure the services and support we provide.

A Christmas fundraising stall, which included a raffle, was held at Tesco Clitheroe with the proceeds benefiting VIC.

Administrator Amy Thompson collected a fabulous cheque for £502.20 from the store and we would like to say a huge thank you to Shelley Bergman, who is pictured third left with store manager Paul Blackburn, and volunteer Carol Barlowe.

A video highlighting the work of VIC has been made for Lancashire County Council who provided a £750 Warm Space Grant to ensure the VIC Centre is there and open when ex-service

personnel and the wider community need us.

We also received £600 from the ASDA Foundation and a large donation of hamper items from Rawtenstall Community Champion Laura Saxton.

Operations Manager Phil Speddy said: "This will go a long way to help with supporting our veterans over the next few months.

"Every year we distribute around 70 food hampers over Christmas and were able to add more items to each hamper."

The Flag 5 in Wardle, who arrange and maintain a flag display in the village, presented funds raised to VIC.

We were visited by Phil Richards (Taffy) one of the five members of the Wardle community group that organises the display, and he donated £500 to VIC as a thank you and in support of the work VIC's

Hilton Jones Accountants, matched this donation bringing the total to £1,000.

Operations Manager Phil Speddy said: "This is a very generous donation from both the organisation and the accountants, and we are very grateful."

Throughout the festive period, the VIC Choir has been singing in Asda and Tesco Supermarkets and staff and customers have given generously.

Tony, who served in the Royal Irish Rangers and had been a VIC member for 8-9 years, passed away peacefully on November 29.

He was a regular at the Sandbag Cafe in Heywood and nothing was too much trouble for Tony when it came to veterans.

He used to pick up some of the older veterans and would take them to the Sandbag Cafe and Rochdale Veterans' Breakfast Club.

He helped deliver our Christmas food hampers and we are very grateful for his support over the years.

Tony's funeral was held at Rochdale Crematorium on December 10 when 11 Royal Irish Rangers escorted the hearse, three Standards were paraded and more than 40 veterans were waiting outside at the crematorium.

Our sincere condolences go out to his family and friends.

Support for Bury art shop


THANK you to everyone who has supported our Bury shop at The Mill Gate Centre.


Battlefields Tour 2026
